Berea Spoonbread Festival Corn Hole Tournament Rules

Setup of Boards

Boards will be placed 27 feet apart (front of board to front of board).

Boards measure 2' x 4' in size and utilize a 6" diameter hole.

Four (4) 1lb/ 6x6 bags will be used for each game

Two teams of two players, (partners) shall play. Partners shall stand at opposite boxes on the same side.

The foul line (an imaginary line) continues in either direction from the front of the playing surface (the foot foul line).

Game Play

Double elimination will be played

The first team to score 21 points (or more) wins.

Each team will keep track of score and notify an official of Berea Spoonbread Festival of the winner.

An official of the Berea Spoonbread Festival will keep track of player brackets.

Round one in each game will be determined by a coin flip, the winner will have honors.

A player must throw from their side of the board anywhere behind the foot foul line.

Game continues by alternating throws between the two opponent players until all bags have been thrown.

Winner of each round will then have honors and throw first, the next round.

The next round starts when the other player on the team, which has honors, throws their first bag.

The game continues until one team reaches 21.

The Spoonbread Official/Judge will have final authority.

A team member from the winning team must be present at the scoring table to get next game assignment. If both members are not present at game start time, match will be forfeited (10 minute only grace period).

Scoring

The score shall be taken after all bags have been thrown for a round.

3pts- bag goes through hole

1pt- bag is on playing surface of board

1pt- bag is hanging in hole

1pt- bag is hanging off the edge, but not touching the ground

0pt- bag is on the playing surface but also touching ground

0pt- bag is hanging off the front edge and is resting on a bag that is on the ground (unless the bag on the ground can be removed and the hanging bag does not fall).

Note: Bag cannot bounce onto the board and scored.

Round Score

The team with the highest round score, adds the difference of the two scores to their end game.

If both teams have the same round score, then the game score stays the same and honors stays with original team.

Fouls

All fouls shall be determined by each team and kept track of by each team.

Any controversial issues need to be discussed with Official/Judge of the Berea Spoonbread Festival.

A player's foot goes past the foot foul line, (foot foul).

A player goes out of turn.
