PARADE APPLICATION AND REGULATIONS

Parade participants must abide by all rules listed below. Those who do not comply will not be allowed to ride or participate in the parade. Those breaking any rules or regulations during the parade will be removed from the parade.

1. Trailers must not exceed more than 10qby 26qwith 20 riders or less.
2. Vehicles (including all floats, farm machinery, cars, trucks, motorcycles and ATVs) must be driven by a person 18 years of age or older with a valid driver's license and proof of insurance for the vehicle as defined herein. All entries must be inspected by parade marshals and local police the day of the parade and declared to be in compliance with rules to participate in the parade. A brightly colored inspection sign will be posted on the right side of the vehicle or on the back of riders/drivers.
3. Parade participants should ask their own insurance agent if their insurance offers them sufficient protection when their vehicles are in the parade. You must show verification of insurance on a given vehicle for that vehicle to be eligible to participate in the parade.
4. No parade participant will be allowed to have a firearm at any time, except on-duty law enforcement officers.
5. All floats and trailers must be within 6 inches in height from street level or skirted completely to within 6 inches of the ground.
6. All floats and trailers accompanied by people or animals must have adult walkers on each side of the float and/or trailer during the parade event. An adult must be on floats where there are children. The ratio of adults to children should be 1 to 5 for children below the age of 16. The adult must represent the organization sponsoring the float.
7. Anyone entering an animal(s) in the parade will be responsible for cleanup of the animal(s).
8. Entries experiencing difficulties must move to the side of the street so others may pass.
9. No 18 wheeler trucks will be allowed.
10. Children shall not be placed on or removed from any float/truck or any vehicle on the road during the parade unless an emergency necessitates.
11. Children riding in the back of pickup trucks must be seated at all times behind rails or sides of the truck. Trucks must have closed tailgates or enclosed backs.
12. Each pulled entry must have a spotter in the cab, other than the driver, viewing the back to communicate with the driver when there is a problem. If no cab is present, spotter must be beside entry and may be one of the persons walking at a wheel.
13. No golf carts or go-carts except officials and those engaged in pulling entries allowed in the parade. All ATVs must be pre-approved by the Spoonbread Festival Parade Committee.
14. No passengers or riders on farm machinery, other than operator, are allowed in the parade.
15. Candy, cups, Frisbees, beads and other trinkets may be handed out by or near the sidewalk by walkers.
16. No parade participant may ride with feet hanging over the side of the entry.
17. All entrants below 18 years of age must be seated at all times behind the rails of the entry.
18. Walkers and marching band units will not be allowed to stop and perform except at the designated reviewing stand. Parade marshals will monitor the flow of the parade and may warn groups who are moving too slowly to ensure a tight and smooth parade.
19. **Applications / entries postmarked or received after 5 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 15th will not be admitted to the parade.**
20. Neither the City of Berea, Chamber of Commerce, Spoonbread Festival nor the Parade Committee is responsible for any loss, damage, injury or fatality incurred before, during or after this event.
